## The Battle of Bosworth

This week the children were taught about the battle of Bosworth. They were lucky enough to meet Richard III, Henry VII and Lord Stanley who recounted the battle from their perspective. The children have begun to write their own recount about the battle taking into consideration all three views.



In maths this week we have continued to look at place value and have started to tackle the concept of addition. First we used empty number lines and mental strategies then began to look at more formal written methods.
