Literacy

This week the children have been working incredibly hard, learning about the Battle of Bosworth and then making effective notes. They have thought carefully about ways of making this easier and more efficient. They then went on to plan and produce a recount of the battle, remembering correct spelling, grammar, paragraphs, chronological order and time connectives.

Each week the children are involved in a variety of activities as part of their reading carousel and also spelling investigations to help learning spelling patterns.

Maths

Continuing from place value of whole numbers the children have been looking at the partitioning of decimal numbers, moving on to rounding up whole numbers and rounding to one and two decimal places. They have been successful in ordering these numbers and understanding their values. We look forward to them using these skills in a problem solving capacity.
