We have been continuing to learn about place value this week, including decimals. The children have ordered numbers and have talked about rounding and partitioning. The homework is to order decimals. Homework sheets should be stuck into homework books and completed on the next page. Our aim is to have children spend 20 minutes on work in their homework book each week. If they have not completed the work in this time, please just put your initials at the bottom.

Our spelling rule for next week is the prefix 'de-'.
E.g. decode, debunk, deactivate. Investigate by looking in a dictionary!
