#### Home Learning

Please note the following information regarding home learning in Year 6:

**Maths Facts:** Handed out Tuesday, given in the following Monday. The children have been given a Maths Facts Book in which they will complete a page at home each week to build up a comprehensive book of all of their mathematical knowledge.

**Maths Worksheet:** Handed out Monday, given in Friday.

**Reading Task:** Handed out Friday, given in Thursday. This involves a written task and should take at least 20 minutes.

Please also listen to your child **read** at least **three** times per week and record this in your child's reading record.

**SPAG Task:** Handed out Wednesday, given in the following Wednesday.

**Spellings:** The children will bring home a list of spellings, or a spelling rule each Friday which they should use their journal to investigate and practise. They will be tested on the following Wednesday.

**Topic project** x 1 per term.

We may also send work home that needs finishing off.
