In English this week we have been looking at Charlotteville and how it has developed. We compared and contrasted this to Corfe.

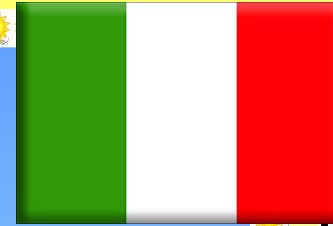
