



Curriculum News:

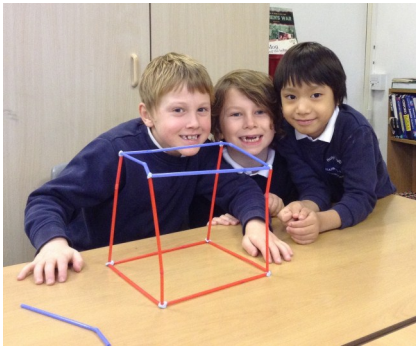


English:
