Maths Focus

This week we have been using our skills of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to help us work out addition and subtraction dragon problem. We worked hard to solve picture, number and word problems eg. a dragon has 15 spikes, 5 fall off. How many spikes are left?

Try solving adding and subtraction word problems at home (in multiples of 2, 5 and 10). Collect a pile of beads, toy cars or pasta. Make up a word problem for your child e.g. You have 24 beads, I take away 2. How many beads do you have left? Challenge by using bigger numbers up to 100.
