

# Just to let you know

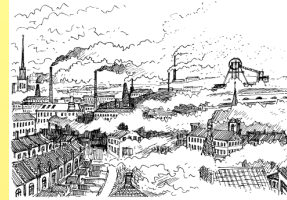
## Dear Parents,
