Please make sure your child completes the data analysis homework by Monday 27th April.



Germination

The children have been looking at The process of germination and have set up seed investigations to observe what the optimum factors are needed for a bean to grow. We have also spent time discussing why a 'fair test' is Important. Why not ask your child to tell you about the variable they have chosen to change in their test.
