

# Year One Beech and Oak 20th September 2013

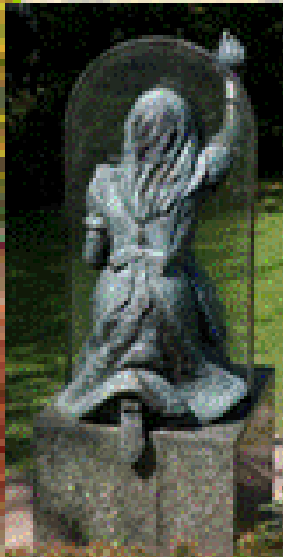
## Maths Focus

This week we have been thinking about counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We have thought about our senses and how many of each body part our senses use, e.g. two eyes, 10 fingers, 1 nose.
