# Trinity Trek

On Friday 19th July it is the Trinity Trek. we will set off from school at 9am and walk over St Martha's and on to Shere. After a packed lunch and rest, we will arrive at Bentley Copse (the walk is approx 10 miles in total). There will be plenty of rests and breaks along the route. After the walk, the children will then cook their own food (in small, closely supervised groups). At the end of the evening the children need to be picked up by parents/carers at 6.00pm.

The children have been put into small groups and together they have planned a dinner which they are going to cook on Trangias (a camping stove) at Bentley Copse.
