



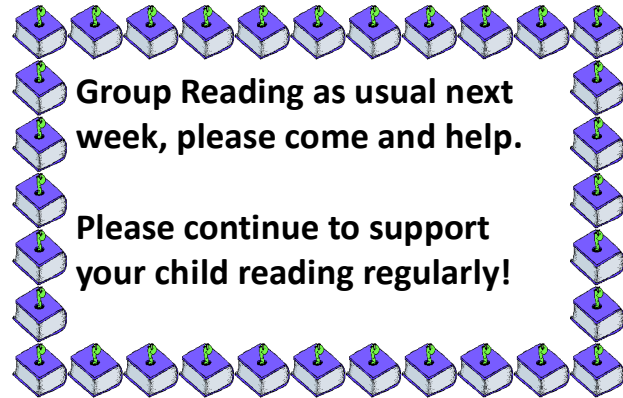
For the amazing creations that the children are designing for the Great Expedition Exhibition we would like to ask you to clear out your craft cupboard and garden shed!
