End of Early Years Foundation Stage 2018

70% of children at HTPD reached a good level of development at the end of EYFS (compared to the national level of 71% in 2017).

A good level of development is defined by the DfE as achieving at least the expected level of development in:

- the Early Learning Goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language)
- the Early Learning Goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

At HTPD, the following average scores were attained in the Early Learning Goals:

Communication6.4 (max 9)Physical4.2 (max 6)Personal6.3 (max 9)Combined Prime16.9 (max 24)Combined Specific19.4 (max 27)
