## Other Bits and Bobs ...

This weekend you could go on your own minibeast hunt in your garden or around the local area. How many minibeasts can you find? Which minibeasts did you find?



You could make a handprint minibeast like in the photo. You will need to paint your hand the colours of your chosen minibeast. Then press your hand onto the paper, while it is drying you can get any little bits ready like wings, eyes or feelers. Once the paint has dried stick or draw on the details.



Odds and Evens—This week in maths we have been exploring odd and even numbers, you could try this fun activity to further explore at home. Choose a number from 1-10, then find that quantity of items, you could collect stones, pasta pieces or soft toys. Then group the items into pairs, if all of the items can be grouped into pairs then you have an even number, if they can't then the number must be odd!
