The children have come back full of energy ready for the term ahead.

Our geography topic this term is '**Home and Away**', starting this half term with learning more about Guildford and the surrounding area. We will then move on, after half term, to learn about Australia, and the differences and similarities between the two countries.

Topic (Geography)

On Friday we thought about different types of habitats and microhabitats, and went around the school grounds to see which ones we could discover. We also compared what living things could be found in sunny and shady places.



Maths

We have focussed on measuring in millilitres and litres this week, as well as looking at temperature. We have considered the difference between capacity and volume and enjoyed using a range of measuring equipment to measure certain volumes of water. We found it fascinating to watch how thermometers show temperatures when put into containers of hot and cold water, and have practised our number line reading skills.

English

In English this week the children have been writing fact files about animals native to Surrey. They have used their skills to find information, make notes and then turn their notes into full sentences. Ask your child what animal they have been writing about!
