



Addendum to Behaviour Management Policy Following Coronavirus

This addendum forms part of the Positive Touch and Physical Intervention Policy and should be read in conjunction with the Positive Touch and Physical Intervention Policy.

The following behaviours will need to be encouraged (through discussion with parents at home, through class charters, through introducing clear expectations and routines and through positive reinforcement). Should any of these behaviours not be followed, SLT should be informed and parents will then be involved in making sure everyone is safe.

Children should:

- follow any altered routines for arrival or departure (coming into school and leaving through specified doors)
- follow school instructions on hygiene: such as handwashing, and sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- follow instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing)
- tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- follow instructions about use of toilets
- use appropriate language regarding the coronavirus situation, not teasing or being unkind

The Governing Body of HTPD first adopted this policy in April 2020. It will be reviewed and revised by the Governing Body as often as may be required.
