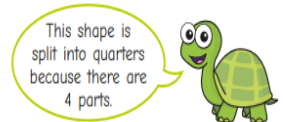


Dear Parents & Carers,

It was lovely to see our pupils back in school and looking rested this week. We have been very busy – here's a little bit about what we've been up to.

Maths

In maths this week, we have been calculating the perimeter of rectilinear shapes and regular polygons. We then moved on to fractions and understanding the meaning of equal parts.

English

In English, we have been learning about past tense verbs and exploring the different spelling rules, such as when to add -ed, -d, or other endings—these patterns also feature in our spellings this week. We then began our new text, *The Iron Man*, writing an exciting introduction and finishing the week by creating our own Iron Man-themed haiku poems.

Science

In Science, we have been learning about the different states of matter—solids, liquids, and gases— and how materials can change from one state to another. We then explored reversible and irreversible changes, investigating which processes can be undone and which result in new materials being formed.

Spanish

In Spanish, we had an introduction to animal vocabulary, learning the names of different animals and practising how to say them aloud with accurate pronunciation.
