They also loved taking part in or watching the House Bake Off Competition. A huge well done to all the bakers who took part! The creativity and effort were fantastic.

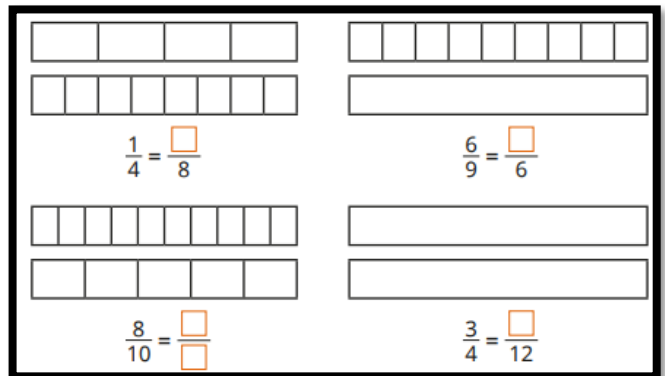

Maths

In maths this week, the children have been exploring equivalent fractions using both number lines and bar models. They have been learning how to identify and represent fractions that have the same value, even when they look different, by placing them accurately on a number line and comparing them through bar model diagrams. This has really strengthened their understanding of how fractions relate to each other and how we can show equivalence in different visual ways.

This brings us to the end of our fraction's unit for now. After the Easter break, we will be moving on to our new topic, mass and capacity.
