Maths

We spent time learning about grams and kilograms before consolidating this by tackling some word problems using our four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We then began looking at volume and capacity, using water to discover that even though a container might be really tall it might not hold the most water (have the greatest capacity).
