Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been another busy and rewarding week in Year 4, finishing with a fabulous day of F.L.U.F.F.Y activities on Friday, which was filled with new skills, creativity and a lot of fun.

English

This week, the children developed their reading fluency and worked together to answer comprehension questions using a range of strategies. They then independently tackled an inference question, showing how well they could apply their understanding.

Spellings for Mon 1st June: The 'ch' digraph (when used to represent a 'k', a 'sh' or a 'ch' sound)

scheme, chorus, echo, chemist, chalet, chef, brochure, machine, chief, challenge.

Maths

The children practised estimating money using number lines and used this to solve real-life problems, such as deciding what they could afford. They also developed their calculation skills with money and explored time, including days, weeks, months and years.

PSHE

In a calm and supportive environment, the children learned about the physical and emotional changes that happen during puberty. The children listened intently and asked some thoughtful questions. Be prepared for more questions at home!

Computing

This week, the children designed and programmed their own wrapping paper patterns using shapes, loops and procedures. They showed perseverance when debugging their code and enjoyed evaluating their final designs.
