Dear Parents & Carers,

This week we have been learning about butterflies. The children have enjoyed using symmetry to create some butterfly artwork. We also had a go at making a butterfly with moving wings, using a peg and some decorated paper. On Wednesday, the children had a great afternoon watching the HT choir perform some songs. The children even joined in and learnt some actions!

Maths: Our maths lessons have linked well with our learning on butterflies and symmetry. The children have been deepening their understanding of what a double is. They know that a double is also an even number and that it is made of two equal parts. The children can explain that the even numberblock numbers have flat tops

Phonics: This week we introduced the children to CVV words such as “free” and “tree.’ We have also introduced them to CCCVC words including, ‘screen’ and ‘street.’

Tricky words: We have been recapping some of the tricky words that the children have learnt so far.

Transition: Thank you for filling in your friendship forms. As we prepare the children to move into their new Year 1 classes, we will be swapping some children between both Hazel and Willow Class over the next few weeks. This will help inform our decisions when creating groupings for new classes.
