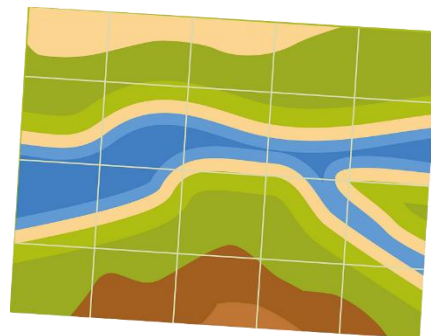


Just To Let You Know
