Dear parents and carers,

We have had another lovely week in Year 2 with the children settling in very well.

This week, in maths, we have been recapping the value of digits in a number and ensuring we recognise tens and ones. We have represented this information using tens frames, dienes and numerals. For example: $25 = 20 + 5$

In English, we have continued to learn the story 'Mrs. Armitage on Wheels' by Quentin Blake. We have also started learning about adjectives and nouns and writing multiple adjective sentences. In Art, we looked at Primary and Secondary colours before having a go using some water colours to practice colour mixing.

In Science, we launched our 'World of Inventions' topic with our first lesson looking at materials. We discussed what words we could use to describe different materials (hard, soft, bendy, stretchy, opaque etc) before testing lots of materials to see if they would bend, stretch, twist or squash and recording our results.

We have also recapped the zones of regulation in PSHE, had a fun music lesson and learnt about 'balance' in computing – we talked about balancing screen time with going outside or playing a game.

Some helpful reminders:

- PE will be on Mondays and Wednesdays. Children will be changing in school so please send them in with their kit in a bag and make sure they are wearing or bring their trainers.
- We are experiencing some very wet and changeable weather. Please make sure children come to school with a coat.
- Please keep an eye out for your child's reading folder which will have come home on Friday with a book to read. Please return these in the folder every Thursday.

If your child is on Fluency (chapter books) they will not have a book in their folder as this will come home next week (we read them over two weeks in school before sending them home).
